Robert Meyer, Contract Account Manager with American of Davenport, recently earned the Certified Graduate Associate (CGA) designation from the National Association of Home Builders. According to the National Association of Home Builders, Mr. Meyer is the first Association member in Iowa to receive this designation.

Candidates earn a CGA designation by successfully completing an intensive series of four six-hour courses. The CGA curriculum incorporates training by leading building industry practitioners and academics on a range of topics, including business management, emerging technologies and market trends. After earning the CGA designation, program graduates are required to maintain their designation through completion of an additional twelve hours of training every three years.

Lenny Wilkinson, owner of Bettendorf Home Repair & Remodeling Inc., was recently awarded his certification as an instructor for the Lead-Safe Renovator course by the Iowa Department of Public Health. Under new rules and regulations that went into effect in April, 2010, any professional remodeling work done on private residences that were built before 1978 must be done by contractors who have taken and passed certified courses in Lead Paint Removal.

Mr. Wilkinson is one of the few certified instructors for this mandated course who is local to the Quad-Cities.
